Value of Time

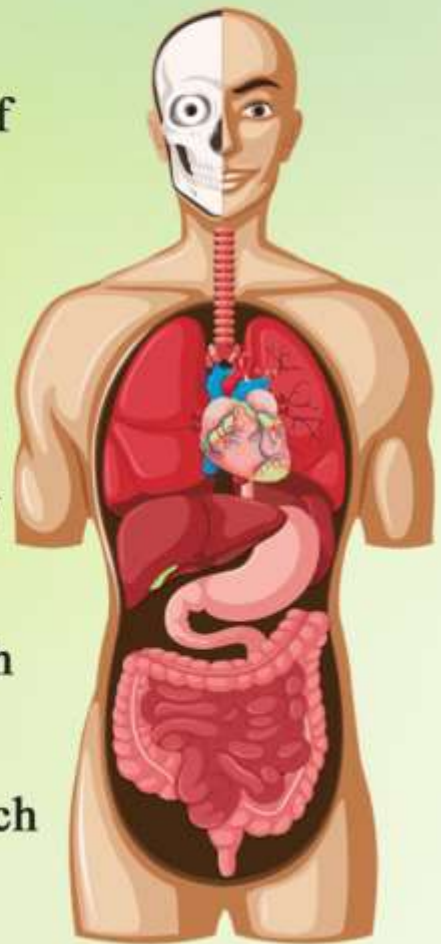


- Time has great importance in our life.

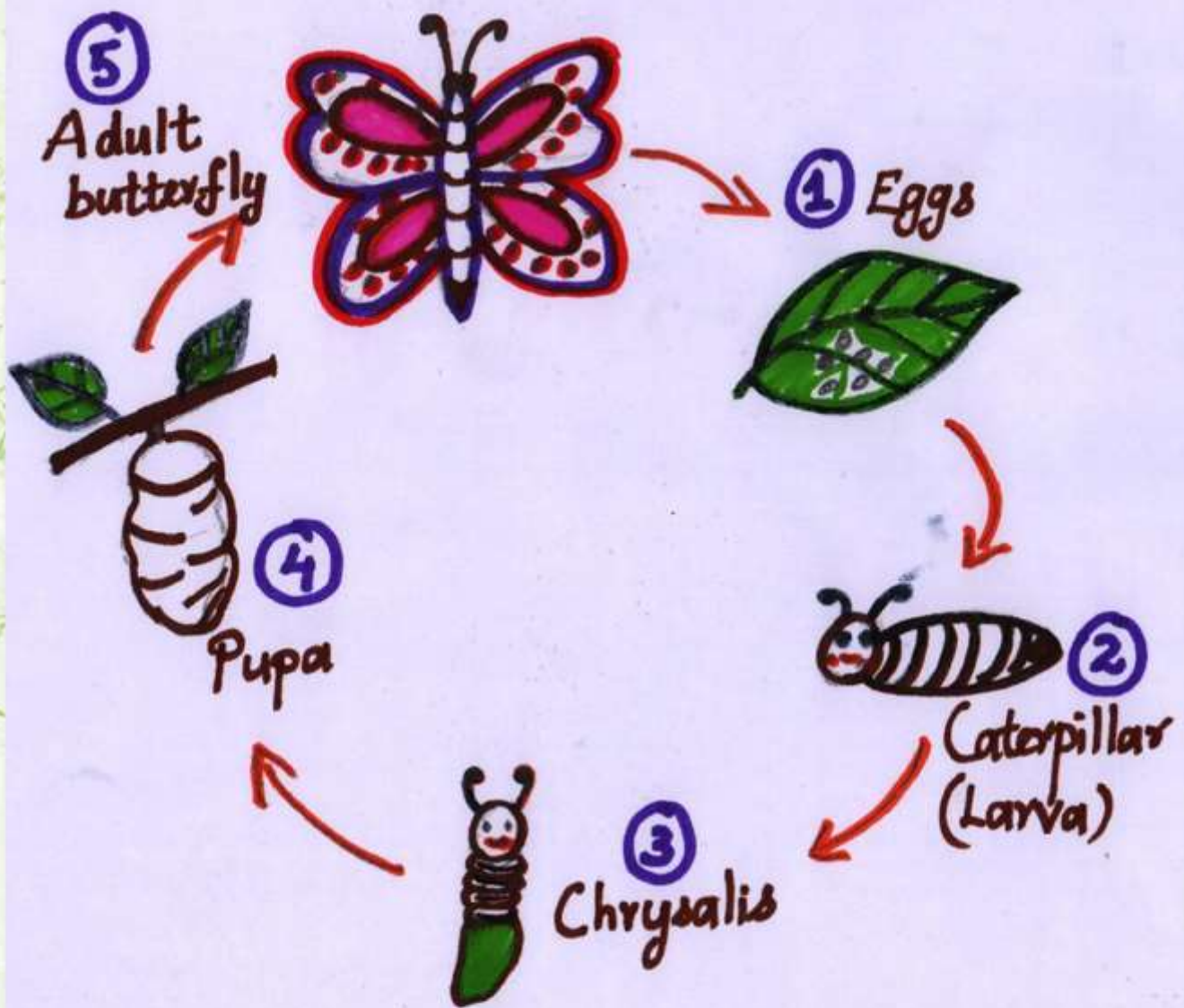

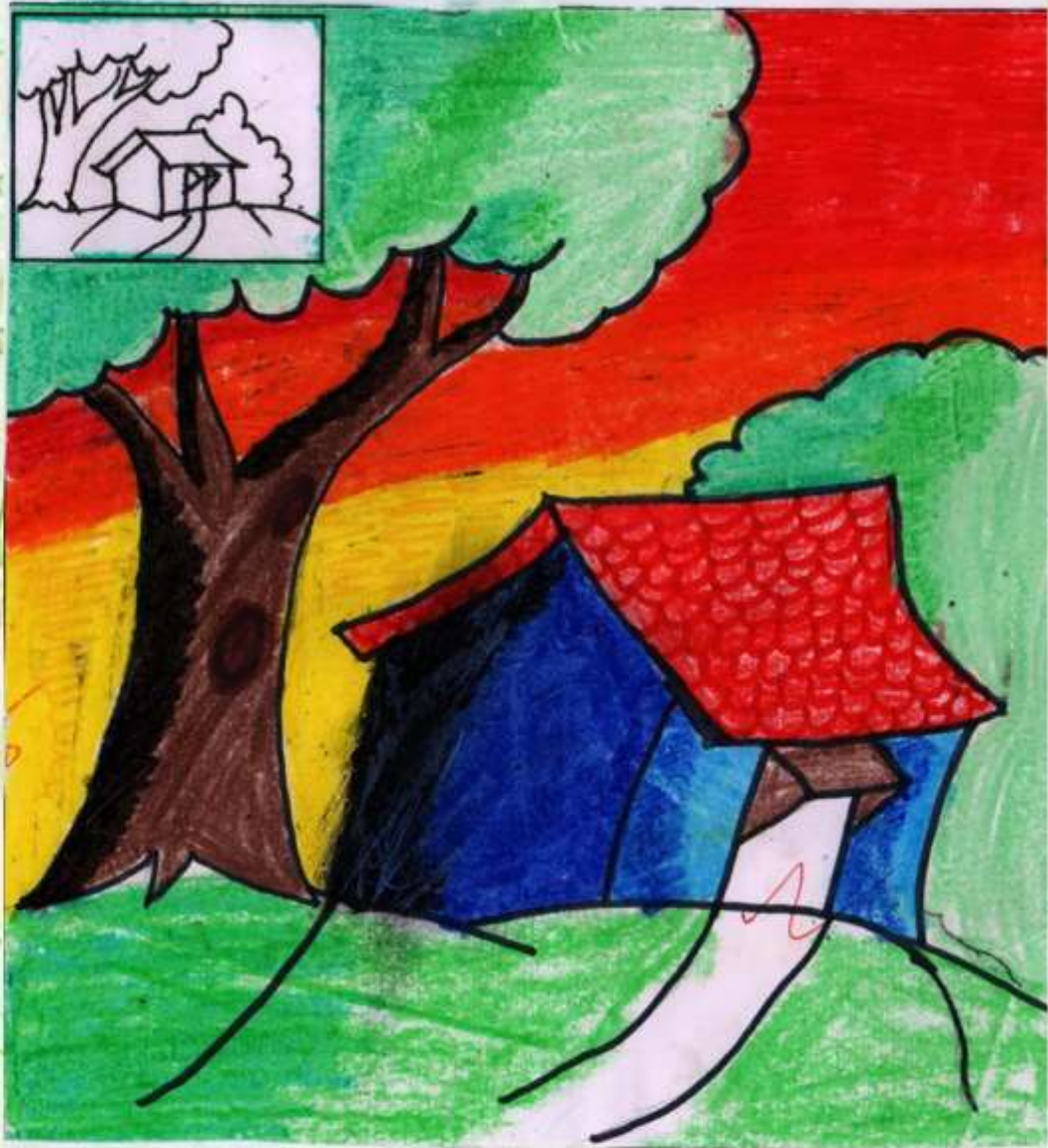
Some Interesting **FACTS**

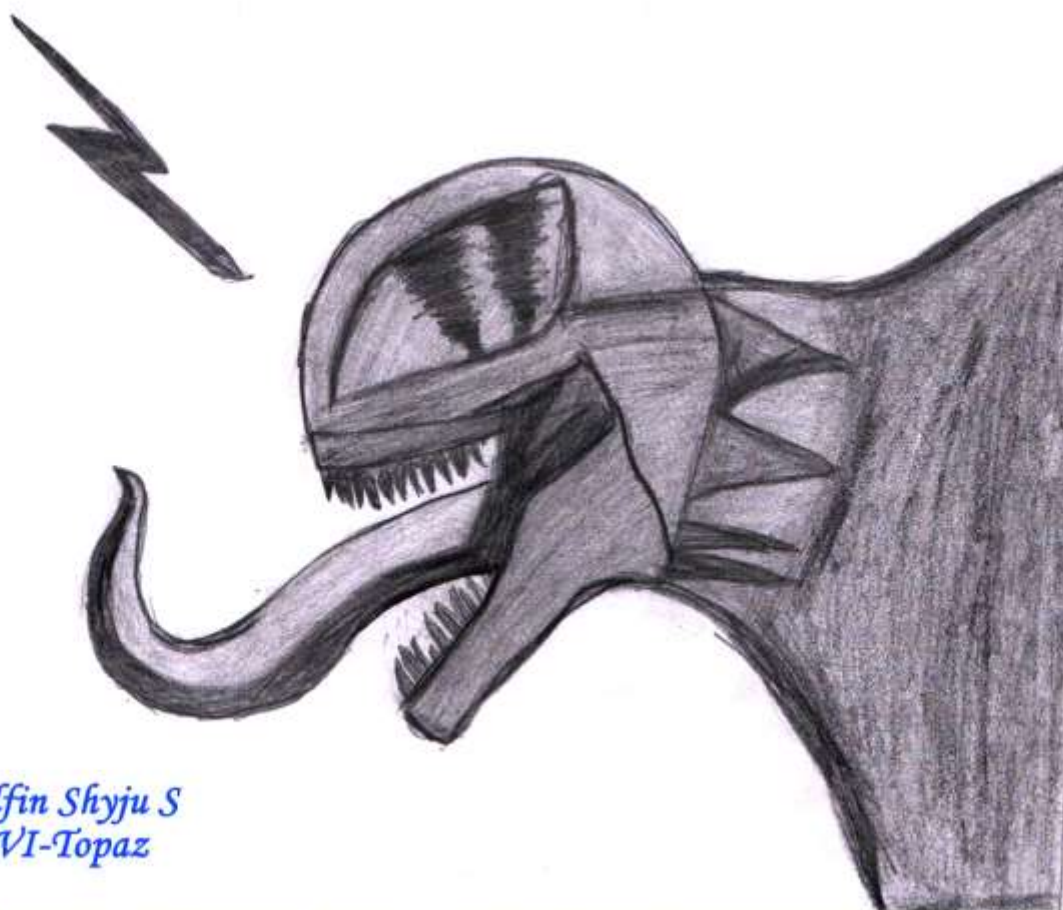

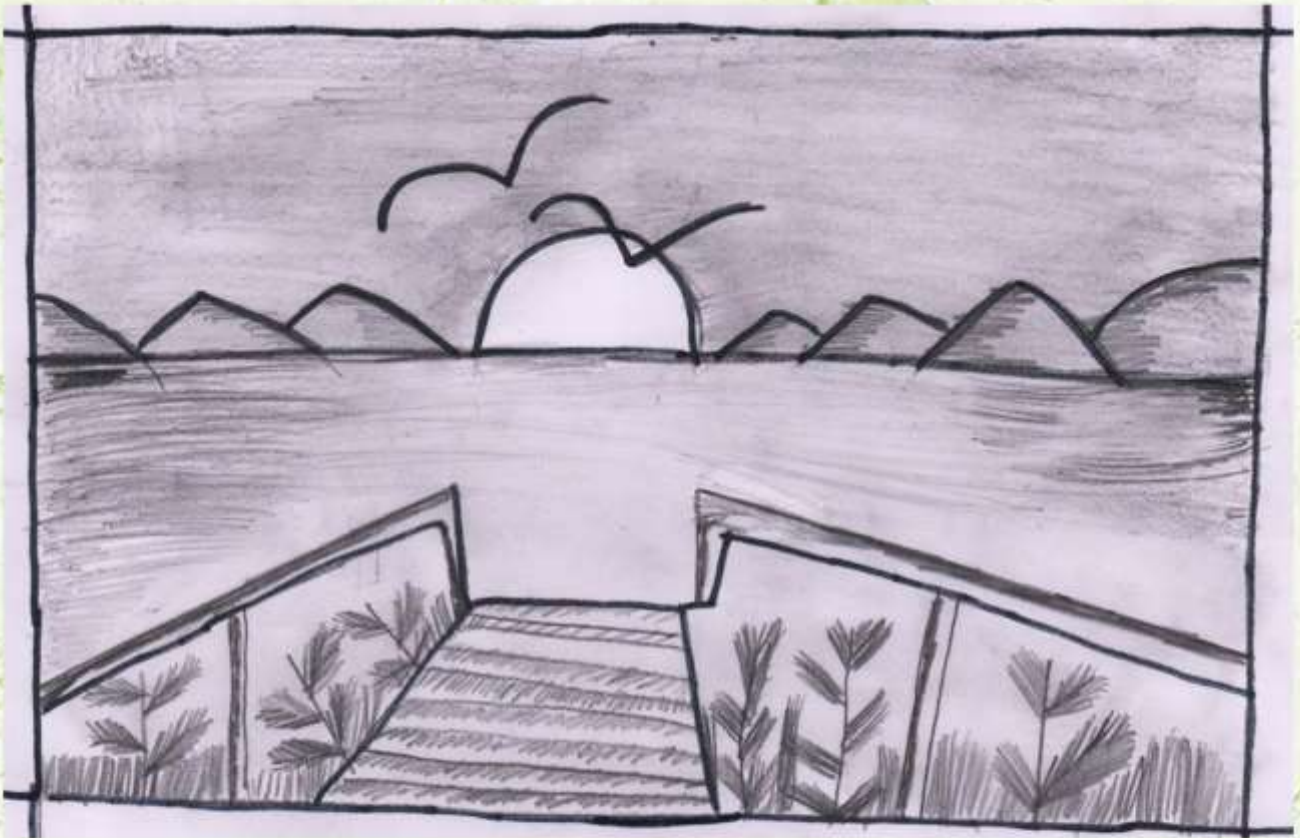

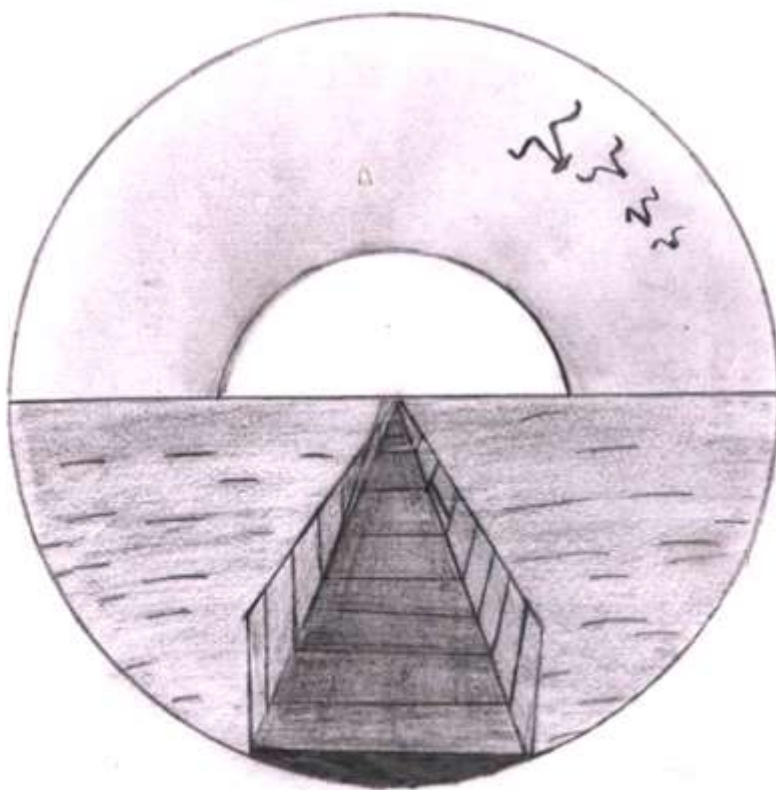
